

MICHAEL MURRAY is Professor and Head of the School of Psychology at Keele University. Previously he held positions at Memorial University, Canada, University of Ulster, Ireland, and St Thomas' Hospital Medical School, London (now King's College). He is a Visiting Professor at City University, London and has also held visiting appointments at Durham University and Massey University, New Zealand. He has (co-) authored or (co-) edited several books including *Health Psychology: Theory, Research and Practice* (with Marks, Evans & Estacio), *Critical Health Psychology* and *Qualitative Health Psychology: Theories and Methods* (with Chamberlain). He works to develop a critical social psychological approach to the study of health, illness, ageing and well-being that is insightful and change oriented. From a theoretical perspective he is interested in social-community psychology and social representation and narrative theory. From a methodological perspective he is interested in qualitative, participatory and arts-based research approaches. He was a founding member of the *International Society of Critical Health Psychology*.
