

MIRCEA MICLEA is Professor of Cognitive Sciences and Cognitive-Behavioral Psychotherapy at “Babeş-Bolyai” University. He did fundamental research in defense mechanisms and anxiety and, more recently, he has focused on applied research and development of psychological software (multiuser platforms for psychotherapy or counseling). As former minister of Education in Romania, he has extensive experience on converting research into public policies and practices. He has authored and co-authored several influential books including *Cognitive Psychology*, *Neuro- Cognitive Models*, and *Stress and Defense Mechanisms*. For his achievements, he has been awarded by Romanian Academy of Sciences (1992) and with Milton Erikson Award for young scholars (1999).
